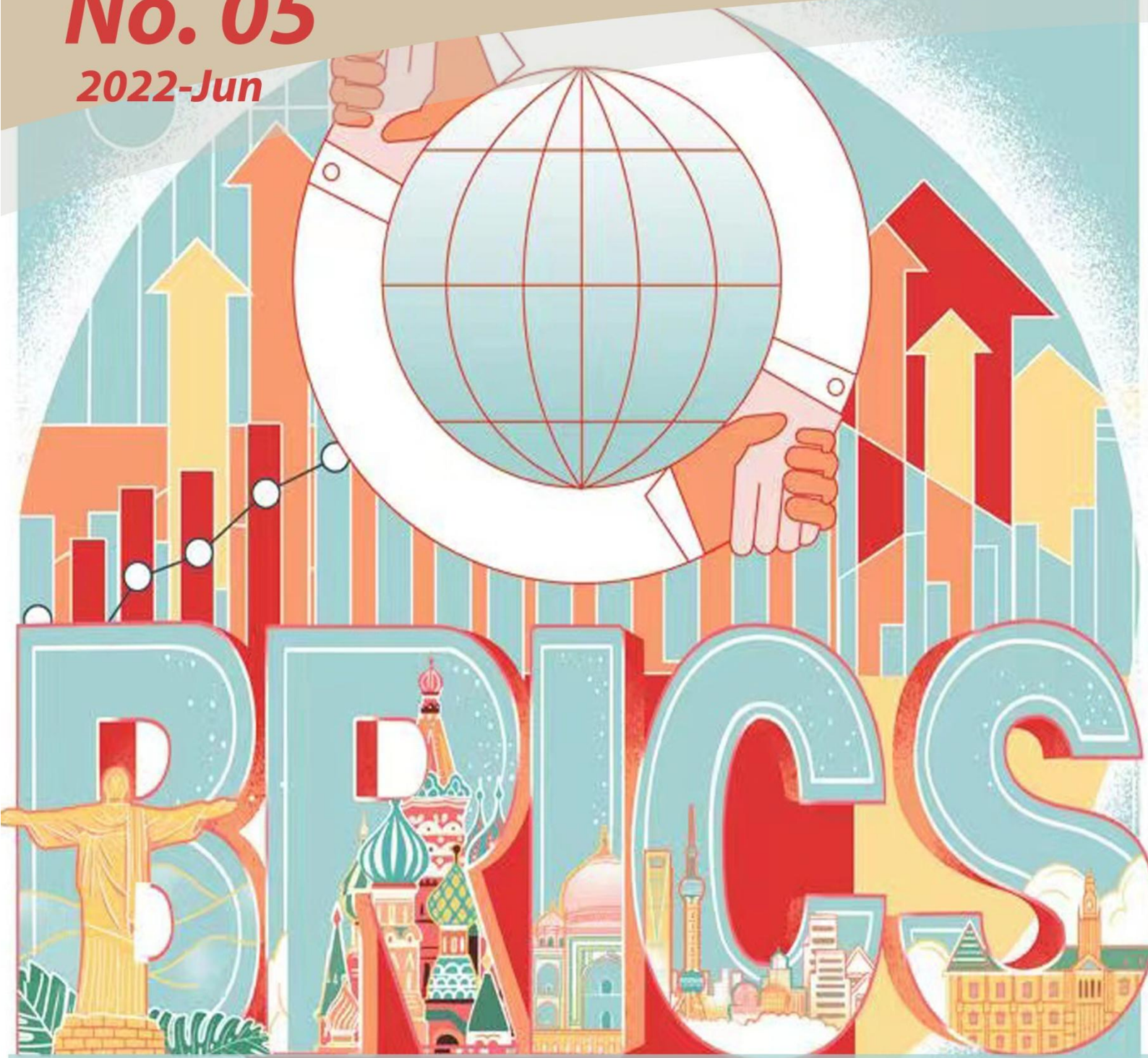

# Editor's Letter

On June 23, President Xi Jinping chaired the 14th BRICS Summit and delivered important remarks, which is of great significance to jointly safeguarding international fairness and justice, revitalizing the cause of global development, and promoting the building of a community with a shared future for mankind. At the opening ceremony of the 2022 annual meeting of the Boao Forum for Asia on April, President Xi Jinping delivered a keynote speech entitled “Rising to Challenges and Building a Bright Future Through Cooperation”, in which he proposed for the first time a global security initiative. This important initiative clearly answers the question of the moment: What kind of security concept does the world need and how can all countries achieve common security. It responds to the urgent need of the international community to maintain world peace and prevent conflicts and wars, and provides a Chinese solution to international security challenges.

At Chinese government's invitation, Mrs. Bachelet, the UN High Commissioner for Human Rights, visited China from May 23th to 28th, and paid field visits to Guangzhou and Xinjiang. During the visit, President Xi Jinping met with Mrs. Bachelet by video meeting, and State Councilor and Foreign Minister Wang Yi met also with Ms. Bachelet. The two sides had extensive and in-depth exchanges in the spirit of mutual respect and frankness. China gave Mrs. Bachelet a comprehensive and in-depth account of China's human rights development path, philosophy and achievements, and the two sides exchanged views on global human rights governance, multilateral human rights work, and cooperation between China and OHCHR.

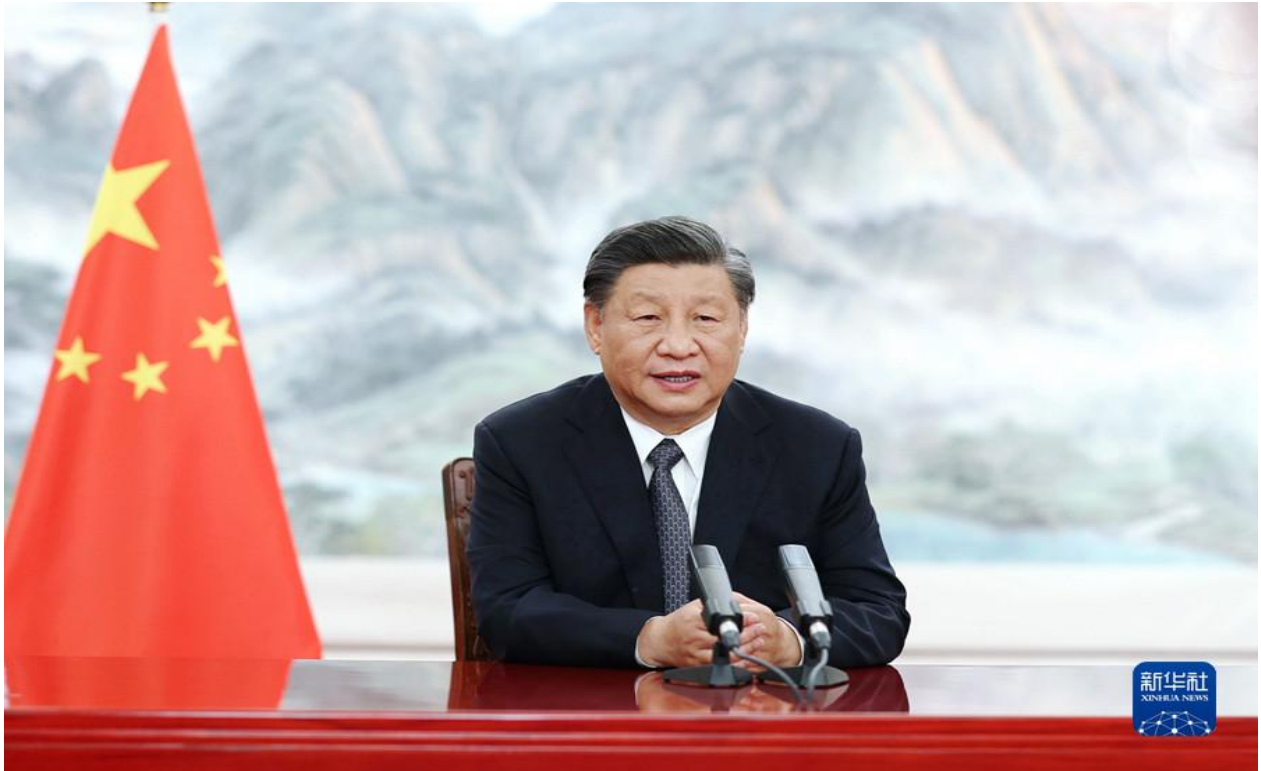
Since the outbreak of the coronavirus epidemic, the Chinese government has always insisted on putting people and life first, on preventing importation of the virus and national bouncing back, on the dynamic COVID-zero policy, and on constantly adjusting prevention and control measures according to the time and situation, thus achieving significant strategic results in the prevention and control of the epidemic. On the premise of strictly adhering to the bottom line of not having a large-scale rebound of infections and ensuring controllable risks, Shanghai since June 1st has fully implemented the normal management of epidemic prevention and control, and fully restored the normal production and life order in the city.

Since March this year, different factors as the complex evolution of the international situation, the repeated coronavirus challenges occurred, impacting China's economy, which has been recovering well. Despite all the hits and blows, the fundamentals of China's long-term economic progress remain solid, and the Chinese government has taken a strong set of policy measures in order to stabilize the economy. On the basis of insisting that the epidemic should be prevented, the economy should be stabilized, and development should be safe, China is accelerating the construction of a new development pattern, building a strong and resilient national economic cycle system, and insisting on expanding a high level of openness to the outside world.

### ***Xi Jinping: China wants to further promote the policy of opening up to the outside world***



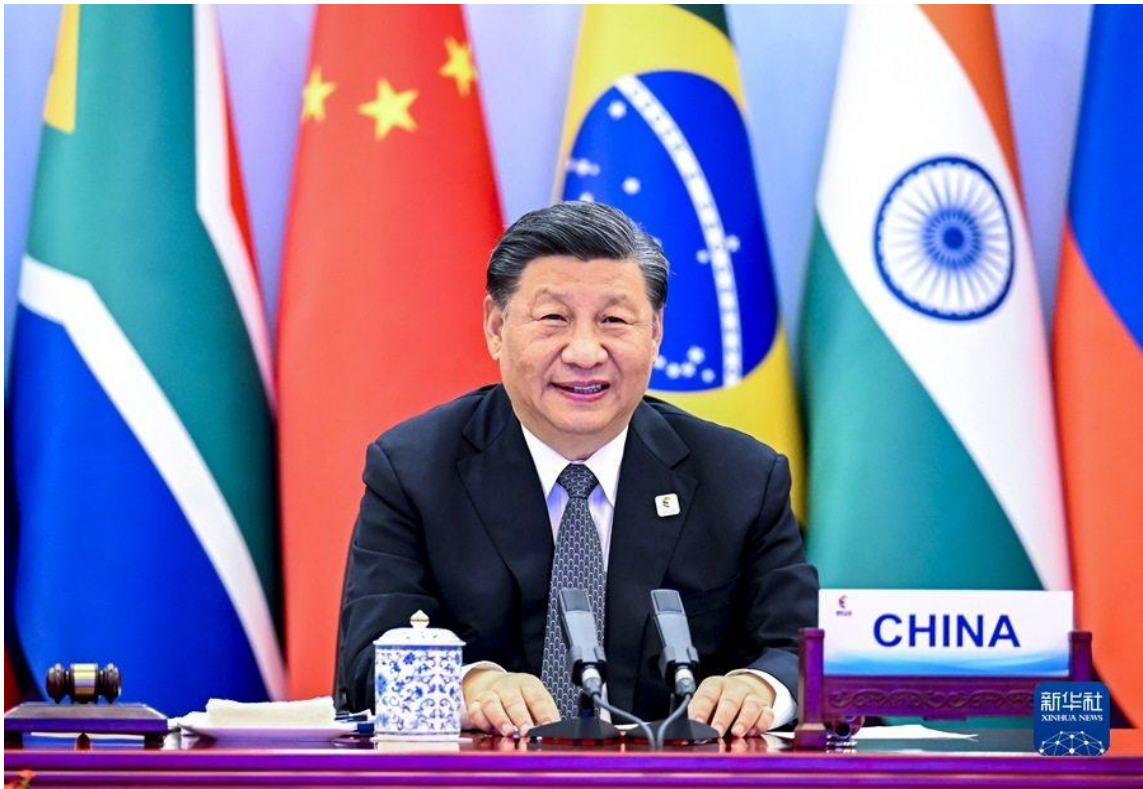

### ***China's foreign trade with other BRICS countries increases in the first five months of 2022***

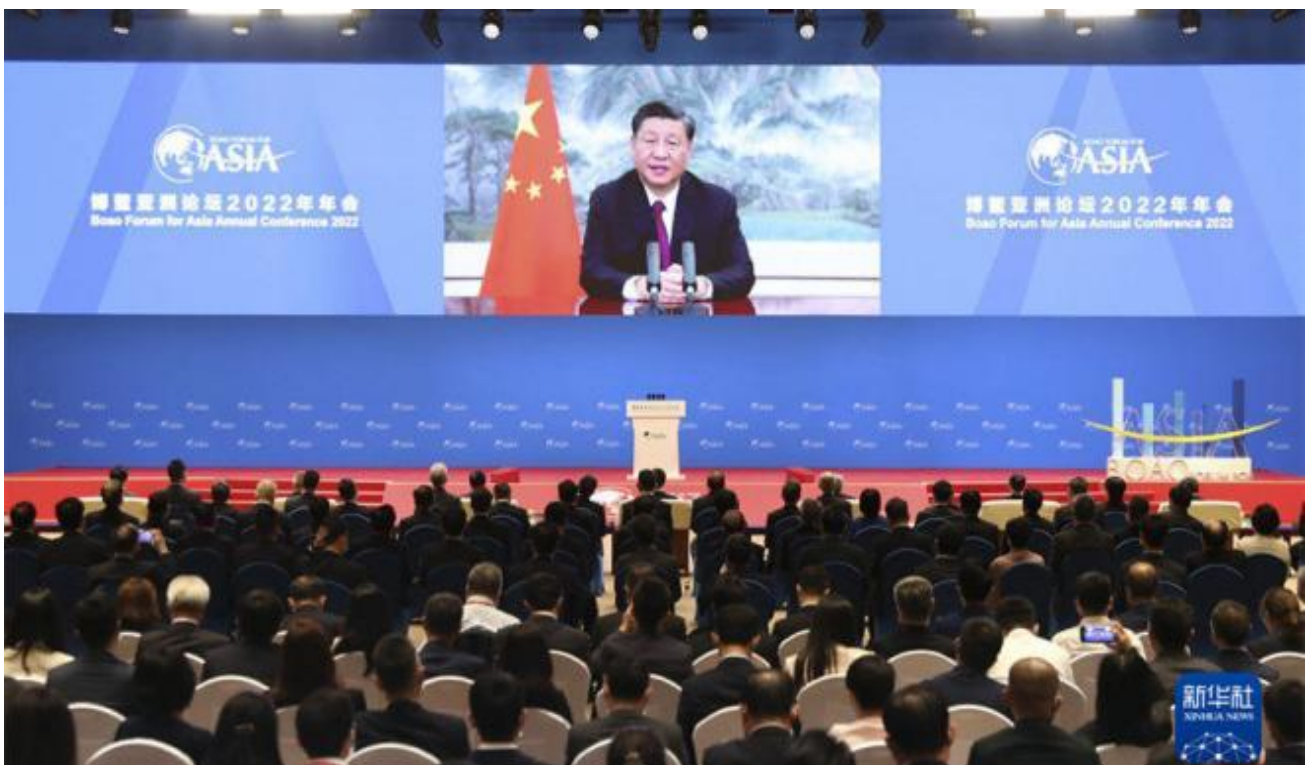

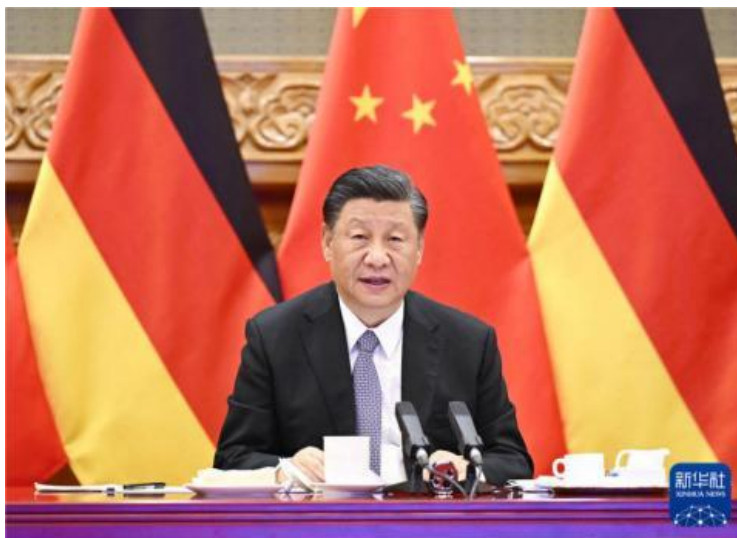




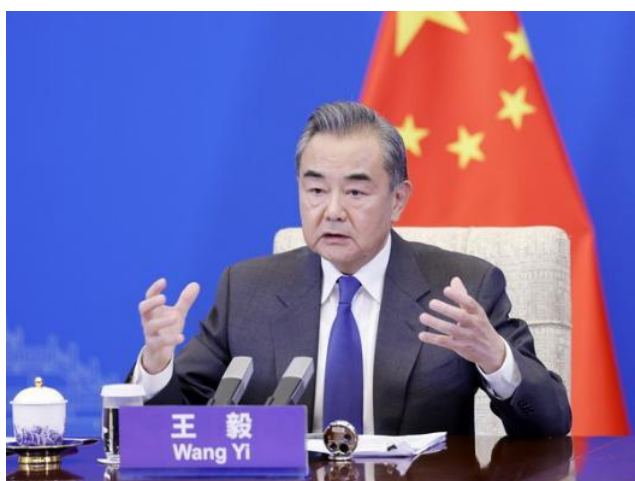
### ***Europe's security should be in its own hands***

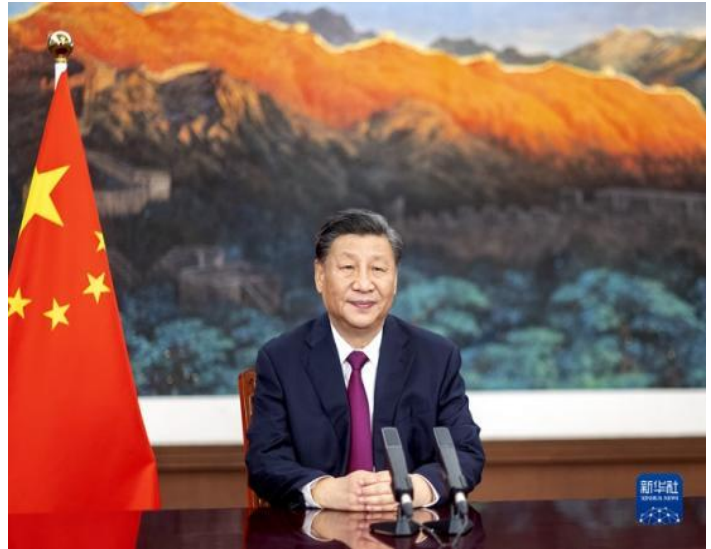
China unveiled its third aircraft carrier in Shanghai on Friday, naming it after the eastern coastal province of Fujian.

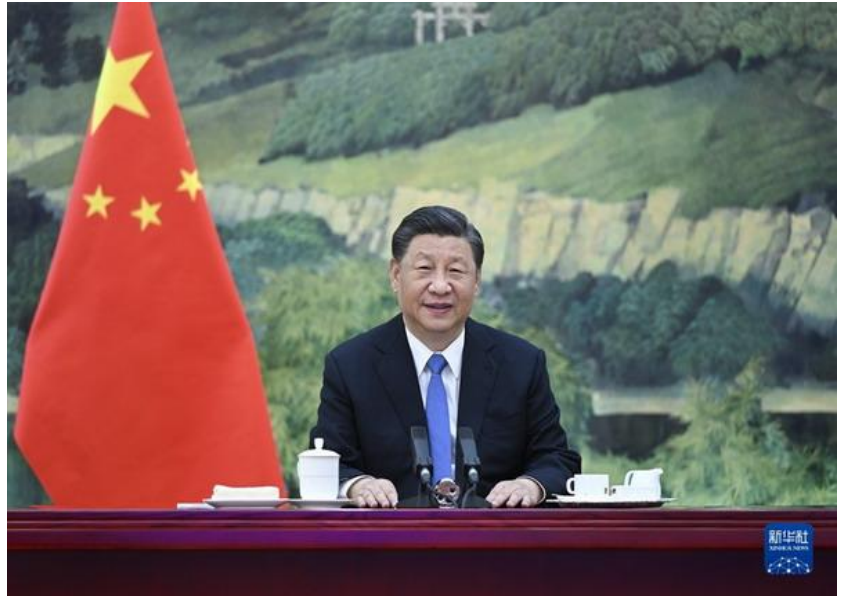

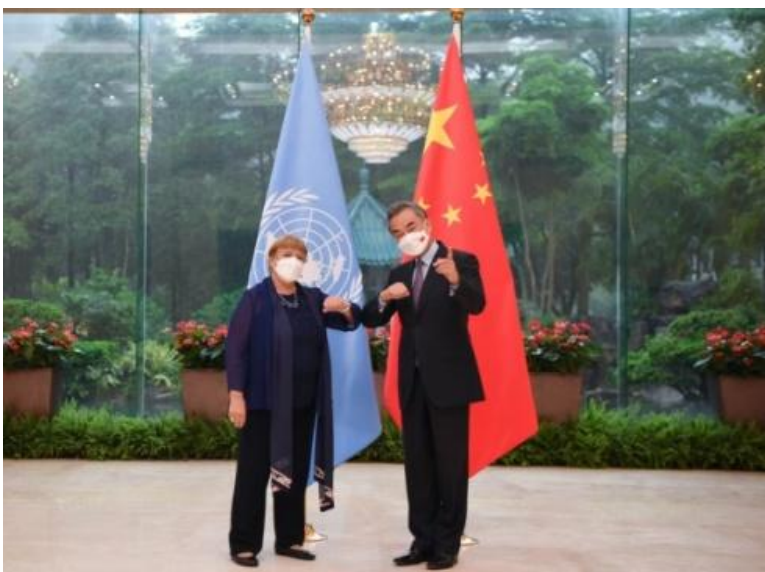
## ***Xi Jinping talks with Michelle Bachelet***

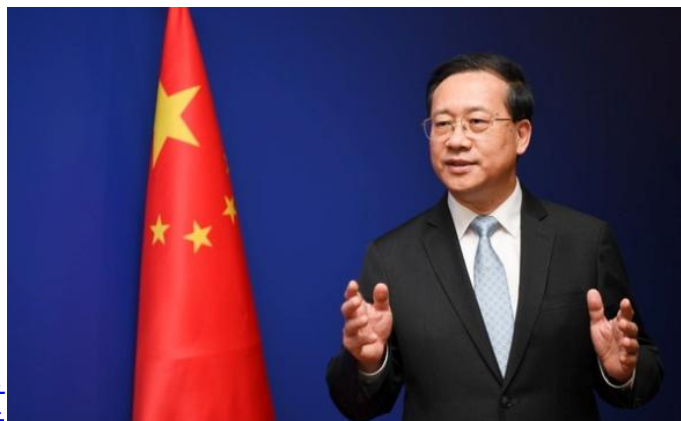

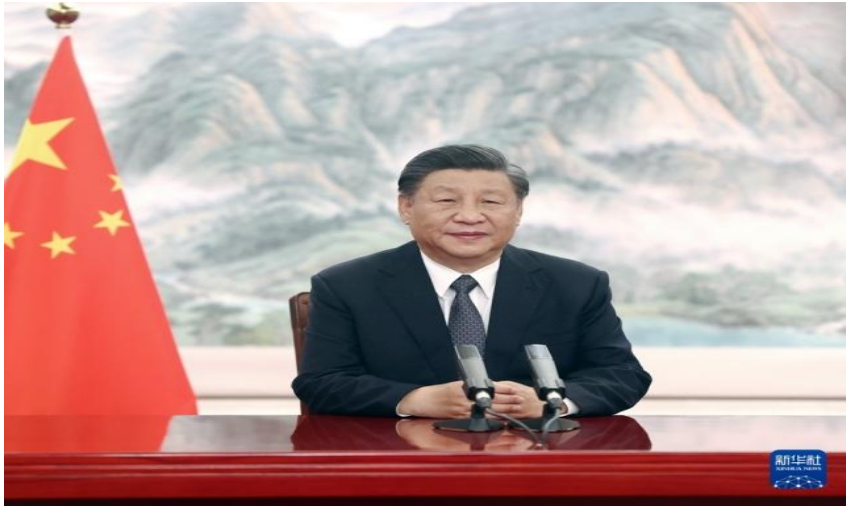
